Airborne Views

At the beginning of July (2021), I had the wonderful opportunity to photograph the inside of St Bertoline's Church, using a drone.

Her name (the drone) is 'Molly' and she's been flying and taking photographs (and video) with me for a good few years now. She loves to fly and can sit very still when she's taking photographs. Yet she can also capture some amazing videos when she's 'on the move'.

St Bertoline's is a beautiful church, inside and out and to be able to record that beauty from a different, third dimensional viewpoint is a joy. Molly has exceptional photographic capabilities, and can fly to places where conventional cameras just can't reach.

'Airborne Views' captures aerial photographs and videos for people who require something different, or special. A 'third dimensional' viewpoint to their event (weddings/parties/May-days/fetes/charity work etc)...Additionally we can provide aerial photos/video of property, land/roof surveys, for marketing purposes...and indeed any aerial 'birds-eye-view' that you would like.

We can also help budding drone pilots to learn how to fly safely and legally. The Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) rules are legal requirements. We teach these to all new pilots and demonstrate how to fly safely and within the CAA criteria.

How to use the 'onboard' camera is also included in the lessons.

Lessons are usually for around 2 hours to suit each individual's requirements on the day.
